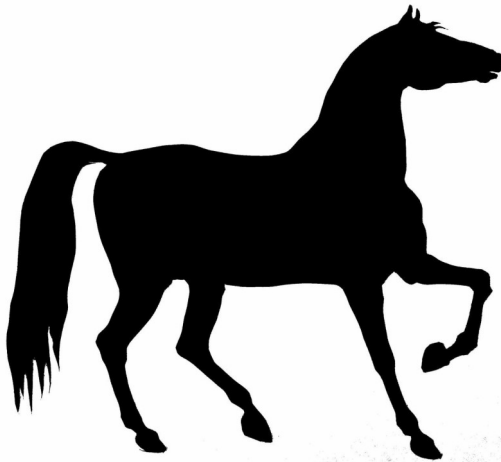




Congratulations to our Youth

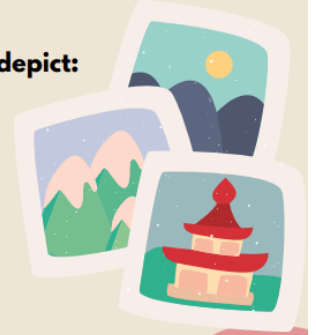

- Each entry should consist of:
 - One completed entry form per photo entry (entry form can be found tiny.utk.edu/tiptonphoto)
 - a JPEG file sent to briggpass@utk.edu or to sydlcrof@utk.edu
 - Your photo should be sized 8 x 10" or 20 x 25 cm or 2400 x 3000 px.
- Entries will be judged on quality and message. The photo (or series of photos) might depict:
 - 4-H project work
 - 4-H exhibits, shows, fairs, etc.
 - Leisure education, camp, etc.
 - Human interest and other

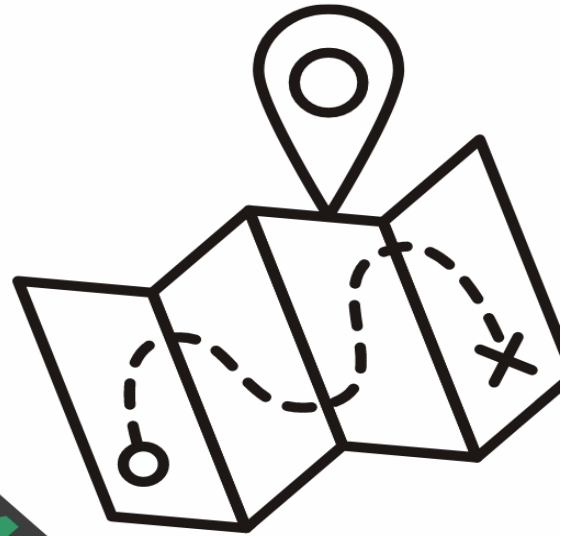
Service Project: We are asking members to donate new umbrellas or other rain gear like ponchos to be given to a homeless shelter.

2022 TENNESSEE 4-H ELECTRIC CAMP

31 Wonderful Years of STEM Education

4-H Electric Camp is a fun-filled, rewarding adventure in electricity. You will explore the world of energy, electricity, energy conservation, electrical safety, and other basic sciences in fun-filled, "hands-on" learning activities. You will work with electrical specialists from across the state in learning centers. Each learning center will consist of hands-on activities so that you can learn by doing. You will also have the chance to meet other 4-H'ers from across Tennessee and explore careers in energy, electricity, and basic sciences. It's an electrifying experience!

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

The cost of the 4-H Electric Camp is **\$300.00/participant**. The fee includes bus, lodging, meals, Dollywood, activities, and take-home items. Registration and fees will be taken through the participants' 4-H office.

WHO CAN GO TO CAMP?

2022 4-H Electric Camp is open to any 4-H member enrolled in **6th or 7th grade as of January 1, 2022**. 4-H members who attended camp as 6th graders are eligible to return and participate as 7th graders.

Jr. 4-H Camp (4th-6th grade) \$330

June 20-24 at the Ridley 4-H Center in Columbia. Campers will enjoy an Olympic-size, crystal-clear pool with a 120' figure-8 water slide, a lighted sports complex with softball field, volleyball and basketball courts. Other facilities include a wildlife center, covered rifle range, airbrush center, a creek for aquatic exploration, modern archery range, low ropes course, and an 18-hole miniature golf course. A bus will be provided for youth to depart from Tipton County and to return to Tipton County.

Electric Camp (6th-7th grade) \$300

June 27-30, 2022 at the University of Tennessee in Knoxville. 4-H'ers will build such items as lamps and compasses, and see many electrical demonstrations on the UT campus. 4-H'ers will also enjoy a trip to Dollywood. Everyone will be housed in the dormitories. A bus is provided with it starting out of Jackson, Tennessee. Campers must find their own transportation to the bus and be picked up from Jackson on their return home.

Line & Design Camp (6th-12th grade) \$130

July 11-13 at the UT Martin. Youth will experience college dorm room life while participating in sewing, shirt making, pottery, and so much more. All supply costs and meals will be provided. Transportation is up to families to get camper to UT Martin.

Target Smart Camp (5th-9th grade) \$355

This camp is all about learning and mastering the art of rifle, archery, shotgun, and hunting and outdoor skills. During free time youth can enjoy the Olympic-size swimming pool, campfires, recreation/nature studies, wildlife center, crafts, and games. July 11-15, 2022 at the Clyde Austin 4-H Center in Greeneville, TN. Transportation is up to families to get camper to Greeneville, TN.

Culinary U Camp (9th-12th grade) \$100

July 13-15 at the UT Martin. High school students will be experiencing dorm room life while learning about careers within the Culinary Field while being in the kitchen. Transportation to and from UT Martin will be up to parents/guardian of youth.

JR. High Camp (7th-8th grade) \$320

July 11-15 at the Ridley 4-H Center in Columbia. Campers will enjoy an Olympic-size, crystal-clear pool with a 120' figure-8 water slide, a lighted sports complex with softball field, volleyball and basketball courts. Other facilities include a wildlife center, covered rifle range, airbrush center, a creek for aquatic exploration, modern archery range, low ropes course, and an 18-hole miniature golf course. A bus will be provided starting from Jackson, TN.

Day camps: These camps include limited registration. We encourage campers to sign up early to

secure camper on our roster. The deadline will be no later than 2 week prior to each camp, if not already full.

Craftastic Camp (4th-8th grade) \$40

June 1st & June 2nd ~~Who~~ **Who** loves a good craft project? Youth will spend the day (9:00am-4:30pm) making different crafts from painting to no sew crafts and so much more! Youth will be engaged by creating their own master pieces! Lunch will be included and all their needed supplies. This event is open for any youth 4th-8th grade.

Kids in the Kitchen (7years old-12 years old) \$25

June 9-10 between 10am-2pm ~~location~~ **location** is TBA. Come join our Family Consumer Science Agent in kitchen where she will be whipping up some fun!

Surviving the wild (4th-8th grade) \$30

June 15th from 9:00am-4:30pm, **location** is TBA. Do you love being outside and tackling different challenges? Come join us for a walk on the wild side with fun and interactive activities. Lunch will be included.

Mad Scientist Camp (4th-8th grade) \$25

June 16th from 9:00am-4:30pm, **location** is Extension Office. Who loves a good Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) challenge? This one day STEM camp will include challenging and engaging STEM activities that focus on the life skill of problem solving, creativity, collaboration, and more. Lunch will be included and all their needed supplies.

Cooking around the World (4th-8th grade) \$30

June 27-30-each day will begin at 8am and conclude at 12:00pm. This event will take place at the Covington Sportsplex, registration for this camp can be completed by calling 901-476-3734.

Mystery camp (4th-8th grade) \$30

July 13th from 9:00am-4:30pm, **location** TBA. This camp will be a jammed packed day of exciting activities but will all be revealed the day of camp. Lunch will be included.

Incredible Chef Camp (4th-8th grade) \$15

July 20-July 22 12pm-4:30pm Does your youth love to cook or have an interest in cooking? Come join us for Incredible Chef Camp where youth will be the chef. This event is open for any youth 4th-8th grade as of January 1, 2021. Youth will showcase their talent by inviting their immediate family at 5:00pm on July 22 for a special event. This camp will be held at the UT-TSU Extension Office-Tipton.

Movie Night (open to any youth 1st-5th grade) \$10

July 29th 7pm-9pm Need a parents nights out? Your child is welcome to attend our movie night that will include a movie, popcorn, drinks, and snacks. All proceeds will benefit future 4-H events.
